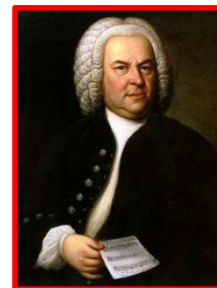
Toe Jam Puppet Band
